**Issues:**

#	Description
1.	<p>The screen did not open and showed a Parser error because of a reference to a non-existing DLL.</p> <p>Now, the screen opens successfully.</p> <p><b>Workstation → Warehouse → Inbound Process → Receipt (RE)</b></p> <p><b>Workstation → Warehouse → Cross Dock → Flow Throughs (FT)</b></p> <p><b>Workstation → Warehouse → Counting → Count Books (CB)</b></p> <p><b>Workstation → Warehouse → Inventory Control → Inventory Adjustments (IJ)</b></p> <p><b>Workstation → Warehouse → Inventory Control → Limbo Adjustments (LJ)</b></p> <p><b>Workstation → Warehouse → Location Management → Location Problem (LOP)</b></p>
2.	<p>During Location Count, when a new load was created using a UOM other than the Lowest UOM, clicking End Count would cause the system to adjust the load quantity.</p> <p>Now, once the user clicks End Count, the load quantity does not change.</p> <p><b>RDT &gt; Counting &gt; Location Count</b></p>
3.	<p>After Parallel Pick, when delivering On Handling Units to a destination location that is not a Staging Lane, the delivery of the first Handling Unit was successful, but the delivery of the next one failed.</p> <p>Now, the delivery of all On Handling Units ends successfully even if the destination location is not a Staging Lane.</p>
4.	<p>Improved management of data connection pools.</p>
5.	<p>When a Dropdown field was defined for a DT in a grid mode, the system retrieved the values of the Dropdown for every line, resulting in redundant calls to the database.</p> <p>Now, the system retrieves the values of the Dropdown only once.</p>
6.	<p>The SBO10Plugin Queue name was incorrect.</p> <p>Now the SBO10Plugin Queue has the correct name.</p>

7.	Edit and Insert screens did not enforce mandatory fields. Now, mandatory fields are enforced.
8.	When the user set the default Report and Label printers via the User Settings, these settings were NOT saved in the User Management → Warehouse Membership tab. Now, when the user sets a default printer via the User Settings, it is saved in the User Management → Warehouse Membership tab.
9.	The DT expression's function <b>GetSessionValue(Warehouse_CurrentWarehouseId)</b> did not work properly. Now, this function works properly and can be used to set default values to fields based on the warehouse the user logs into.
10.	It was not possible to search for DTs using the DT editor of the Customer Access. Now, it is possible to search for and edit Customer Access DTs.
