Issues:

#	Description
1.	Waze and phone call links did not function in the Delivery application. These links are now operational, allowing users to open Waze and initiate phone calls directly from the app.
2.	Photos uploaded by the Delivery application were of low quality. Photo quality has now been improved, providing clearer and higher-resolution images.
3.	Routes with no packages to load displayed the Loading step without an option to skip. Now, the Loading step is automatically skipped, allowing the user to depart immediately.
4.	SCEExpert Connect BCD365 Plugin now supports importing Custom fields.
5.	When importing items from Shopify, SCEExpert Connect was limited to importing up to 100 item variants per product. SCEExpert now imports all item variants.
6.	Exporting the Inventory Snapshot to Shopify did not include item quantities. Now, the Inventory Snapshot export includes quantities for all items.
7.	In some cases where Outbound Order lines and available loads used decimal quantities, the system incorrectly allocated quantities exceeding the available load quantity. Now, the system properly allocates the available quantity.
8.	In some cases where Outbound Order lines and available loads used decimal quantities, the system did not allocate quantities optimally, resulting in unnecessary pick lines. Now, the system optimally allocates the available quantity
9.	In some cases, during wave planning, not all pick tasks were created with the correct priority.

	Now, tasks are created with the correct priority based on the Picking Policy Picklist Release Strategy.
10.	In the Scheduling Applications screen, deactivating a Scheduler Application and reloading the configuration did not stop the scheduler from triggering the application. A service restart was required for the change to take effect. Now configuration reload properly applies both activation and deactivation changes. Workstation → Setup → Scheduled Tasks → Scheduler Applications (SCH)
